Cut eggplant rootstock

stem at a 30° angle

above cotyledon

Tomato Grafting Procedure

Maintain grafted seedlings under low lighting at high relative humidity for 6-7 days

Gently push to ensure contact between cut ends Select scion and rootstock of same diameter (1.6-1.8 mm)

Raise seedlings for grafting (14-16 days)

Move grafted seedlings to net house for hardening (7-10 days)

Attach scion to rootstock with rubber tube

Insert scion stem halfway into 10 mm long rubber tube.

Cut tomato scion stem at a 30° angle above cotyledon or the first true leaf
