 Post-harvest handling and processing of vegetables

On this topic, I will examine post-harvest handling and processing of vegetables that have been done. Then we will teach them the right way

 Food processing and nutrional quality of vegetables

On this topic I will examine how the food processing done by the community and teach them the right way so that the nutritional value of vegetables does not decrease or disappear. The most useful topic that will I apply this action plan is the second one.



IDENTIFICATION OF PROBLEMS

- The consumption of vegetables of Indonesian people is below FAO standard ie 35.30 kg/capita/year in 2005, 34.06 kg/capita/year in 2006 and 40.90 kg/capita /year, while the FAO standard is 73-91,25 kg/capita/year (Daily "Pelita", Friday, October 30, 2015).
- The Ministry of Agriculture has launched "Gema vegetables" recently, but to urge people to eat more vegetables is not enough just to campaign.
- We should be in-depth study why the people of Indonesia have not been eating lots of vegetables.
- A lot of people do not fully understand the benefits of eating vegetables, and can not know how to prepare or cook vegetables properly so that nutrition is not lost.





The objectives of plan are:

Invites the urban and rural community:

- 1. To grow and eat more vegetables increased by 30% from the previous and economic benefit of more than 30%
- 2. To Post-harvest handling and processing of vegetables with either (a decrease in the nutritional benefits only 10%)
